Hello Fellow Colleagues,

Since its founding in 1897, the DTC has aided tens of thousands of DPS employees and their families. The Assistance Fund, which provides medical equipment to all active and retired employees and their immediate family members free of charge for as long as needed, is a very quick and convenient process. A fellow teacher had a visit from her mother over the 4th of July holiday. Because she called ahead, my friend was able to swing by the office where our wonderful assistant, Millie DeRose, had her paperwork ready to sign and the chair ready to go.

The Payroll Protection Plan for full-time employees, at just \$8 a month, is an inexpensive way for you to receive extra income when you must be out for an extended time due to illness. Now is the time to enroll in this program. Open enrollment runs through 12/31/11. Information packets will be in your mailboxes this week. Dear Friends & Colleagues:

As always, the Payroll Protection Plan and the Assistance Fund of DTC are here to meet your needs when a medical emergency arises in your family. Whether you personally suffer an illness or injury and miss time from work, or someone in your family needs a piece of medical equipment, we have the resources to help you out. With the continually increasing cost of medical insurance, higher premiums and higher deductibles, joining the Payroll Protection Plan is an excellent way to off-set some of your out-of-pocket expenses. You are eligible to join the Payroll Protection Plan if you are a full-time DPS employee. If you are unsure about your eligibility, please contact our office at 303-377-0222.

Thousands of DPS employees have benefitted from membership in the Payroll Protection Plan. During the 2010-2011 school year, we paid over \$70,000 in claims. If you missed more than 10 days of work last year due to a personal illness or injury, membership in the Payroll Protection Plan would have paid you \$50 a day for each additional day. The Assistance Fund, an organization fully funded through your generous and continuing donations, ensures that all DPS families have access to the most up-to-date medical equipment whenever you need it, for as long as you need it, free of charge. No other organization in the country provides this service. Every penny that you give to this organization, whether through premiums to the Payroll Protection Plan or donations to the Assistance Fund, is used to provide the services we offer. Even if you never have a personal need, you can take pride in the fact that your investment is providing these services to your co-workers and colleagues.

Congratulations and thank you for your many years of service to the children of Denver. As a retiree, you maintain your privileges with the Assistance Fund. This means you may continue to borrow durable, non-personal medical equipment from us after you retire. The equipment is available to all active and retired employees of the DPS. All you have to do is call us (303 377-0222) or email us (dtclub@qwestoffice.net) to reserve the equipment you need and we'll have the paperwork and the equipment ready for you to pick up. You may use the equipment you borrow as long as you need it free of charge for any one in your immediate family.

To ensure your continued eligibility for these unique services, you must provide our office with information so you can be added to our retiree database. This can be done by completing a DPS Retiree Continuation Data Form which is available in PDF format for you to download from our website - www.denverteachersclub.org. If you do not have access to the internet, please call us at 303-377-0222 and we will mail one to you.

Open enrollment for the Payroll Protection Plan runs through December 31, 2011. This unique insurance plan provides you with extra income when you are unable to work due to personal illness or injury. The Payroll Protection Plan pays you \$50.00 per day for each sick day you use after those provided to you by the district for the year.

There have been many changes to your health insurance plan this year, including increased deductibles and premiums. These expenses can be fully recovered by vested Payroll Protection Plan members when filing a claim. The extra income can make things easier for you whether you have medical expenses not covered by your insurance or need extra cash to cover normal expenses while you are ill. Be sure to file your claim as soon as you know you will be missing more than two weeks of work. You do not need to use all your accumulated sick leave in order to receive these benefits, nor does your participation in any other program prevent you from receiving these benefits.

Your monthly membership premium is only \$8.00 (\$96/yr). However, new members who join now through salary deduction, will **receive an \$8.00 discount on your first year's premium**. Your coverage begins 7/1/11, but you will not make your 1st \$8 monthly premium payment until 8/31/11. By becoming a member, you can receive up to \$250.00 in your first year (\$50/day for five days). Each year through your 5th year of membership, you are eligible to receive an additional five days benefits (for details, see our enclosed brochure). Vested members (6th year+) are eligible for up to 100 days of benefits, or a **maximum of \$5,000.00 in any given year**.
