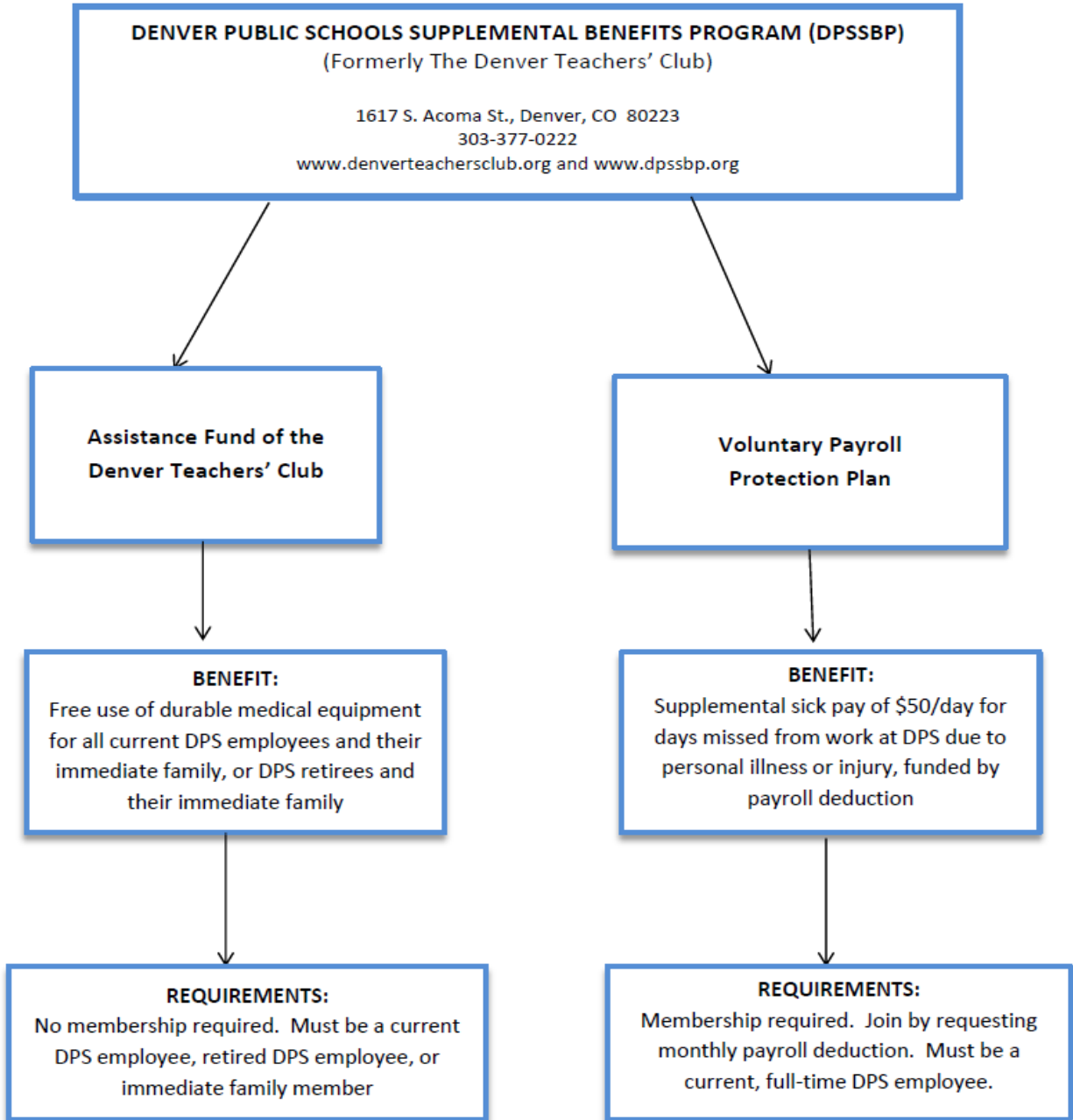

THE DPS SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS PROGRAM / DENVER TEACHERS' CLUB

As an employee or retiree of the DPS, you are eligible for benefits from the Supplemental Benefits Program of the Denver Teachers' Club. We are the oldest non-profit in Colorado, founded in 1897 by William Smiley, Dora Moore, and several other DPS pioneers. Our services are two-fold: free use of durable medical equipment, and additional sick pay.

THE ASSISTANCE FUND: Through our **Assistance Fund**, we provide all active and retired DPS employees and their family members free use of durable medical equipment. Contact our office and let us know what you need and then come by and pick it up. We provide almost everything you might possibly need, including but not limited to walkers and wheelchairs, bath and toilet accessories, bed rails and bed tables, canes, crutches, and mobility items like knee rollators.

THE VOLUNTARY PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN: If you are a current full-time employee, membership in the **Payroll Protection Plan** provides you with cash payments for days you miss from work due to personal illness or injury. We pay our members \$50 a day for every day missed over the 10 or 12 sick days you are provided by the district each year. Benefits are graduated depending on your membership year. Membership costs you just \$10.00 per month through payroll deductions. Be sure to contact your school Representative with any questions, or call the DPS Supplemental Benefit Program at 303-377-0222.

ARE YOU RETIRING THIS YEAR?

Congratulations and **thank you** for your many years of service to the children of Denver. As a retiree, you maintain your privileges with the **ASSISTANCE FUND**. You may continue to borrow durable, non-personal medical equipment from us for yourself or any person in your immediate family for as long as you need it, **free of charge**. **The equipment is available to all active and retired employees of the DPS.**

To be added to our retiree list and to ensure your continued eligibility to borrow equipment, you must complete the **DPS Retiree Continuation Data Form** below and mail it to our office at 1617 S. Acoma St., Denver, CO 80223 – 3624. The form is also available in PDF format for you to download from our website – www.dpssbp.org.

PAYROLL PROTECTION PLAN

OFFERED THROUGH THE SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS PROGRAM TO CURRENT FULL-TIME, SALARIED DPS EMPLOYEES

Enroll now for the 2015-2016 School Year

As a full-time employee of the Denver Public Schools and a member of the **Payroll Protection Plan**, if you need extra cash to cover normal expenses while you are ill, the extra income provided by the **Plan** can make things easier for you. In addition to teachers, facility managers, lunchroom managers, office and administrative employees may join the Plan, as well. The Plan pays benefits of \$50.00 per day after you use the sick days provided to you by the district. Benefits increase in 5-day increments:

1st Year	5 days	\$250
2nd Year	10 days	\$500
3rd Year	15 days	\$750
4th Year	20 days	\$1,000
5th Year	25 days	\$1,250
6th Year (Vested)	100 days	\$5,000

Your premiums are payable monthly through payroll deductions. Cost is \$10 per month, or \$120 per year.

Be sure to file your claim as soon as you know you will be missing more than two weeks of work. All illnesses on claims must be attested to by your physician. You can access detailed information about this unique insurance through our link on the **DPS Employee Benefits website**, or visit our website for the Denver Teachers' Club Supplemental Benefits Program at www.dpssbp.org. Our website contains the membership application, Rules & Regulations document, and claim form.

The membership/claim year begins July 1st and ends June 30th. You can [click here](#) to download an application, see your school Representative, or call our office at (303) 377-0222. Fill out the application and mail the original to the Supplemental Benefits Program office by US mail or DPS mail.
