Tickets will be \$2.00 each, or a book of five for \$10.00. Retired employees will be receiving one order/remit envelope in the mail for tickets. This year, to save costs for mailing and production, no actual tickets will be mailed to you to fill out and return. Instead, according to the remit/order envelope you fill out and return to us with your payment, we will fill out the ticket stubs with your information, detach the stub and place it in our raffle barrel for you. We will keep the other half of your ticket(s) with your envelope. (If you have return home address mailing stickers, you can include some with your remittance for us to stick on your stubs).

Tickets for active employees will be available from your building representative, by calling the Denver Teachers' Club at 303-377-0222, or by emailing us. All raffle-ticket envelopes must be returned to our office no later than noon on the day of the raffle, Thursday, April 20. You need not be present to win.

HELP US WITH OUR RAFFLE: JOIN THE DENVER TEACHERS' CLUB "HELPING HANDS"

Each year the Assistance Fund processes close to 60,000 raffle tickets. We could never accomplish such a feat without the dedicated individuals who volunteer to come into our office and help (our "Helping Hands").

This year, instead of stuffing envelopes, processing may involve actually opening envelopes and filling out ticket stubs from orders mailed in by retirees. It may involve several daily sessions before the raffle, since the mail-in orders will be continual, beginning the last week of February. Since our process will be different this year (the USPS has said we cannot mail our actual tickets or stubs), we are still updating the procedure. Our volunteers have a great time working hard while enjoying lively conversation.

We also use our Helping Hands to mail an additional 1,500 ticket booklets and raffle information to our contacts and representatives at the schools through DPS inter-office mail. We provide a "raffle packet" to each school that contains ticket booklets, a poster, and a letter of instruction for setting out/selling the tickets to the staff at their school. Again, we could not do it without our volunteers!

As a full-time employee of the Denver Public Schools and a member of the **Payroll Protection Plan**, if you need extra cash to cover normal expenses while you are ill, the extra income provided by the **Plan** can make things easier for you. In addition to teachers, facility managers, lunchroom managers, office and administrative employees may join the Plan, as well. The Plan pays benefits of \$50.00 per day after you use the sick days provided to you by the district. Benefits increase in 5-day increments:

1st Year	5 days	\$250
2nd Year	10 days	\$500
3rd Year	15 days	\$750
4th Year	20 days	\$1,000
5th Year	25 days	\$1,250
6th Year (Vested)	100 days	\$5,000

Your premiums are payable monthly through payroll deductions. Cost is \$10 per month, or \$120 per year. Call our office or see your school site representative listed below.
